Dublin Institute of Technology is delighted to announce that it will host two PhD students from Vietnam funded by Ireland's Higher Education Authority through the Government of Ireland International Education Scholarships programme.

Candidates should be registered for a PhD programme at an approved University or equivalent in Vietnam and applicants must have the support of supervisors from their home institution and DIT. Scholarships will be awarded to 2 PhD students to study on a PhD programme at DIT for one year in any of the following fields:

Environment, Energy and Health

Information, Communications and Media Technologies

New Materials and Devices

Society, Culture and Enterprise

Successful candidates will be awarded €10,000 towards visa, travel and living expenses. Project costs and medical insurance will be provided by DIT.
